2 Pre-Accident Plans

• Fire Alarm

- The Designated meeting point outside the building is the Fire and Ice coffee shop inside Fidel Center.
- Evacuate the lab and close the doors. Lead your students to the designated meeting point.
- Verify that all your students arrive at the designated meeting point. Report any missing students to your supervisor.
- Determine if there are injuries and report them to the emergency contacts.
- Life threatening situation
 - call 911
 - report incident to supervisor -note Date, time and persons involved;

3 Lab Safety Rules

- No food is allowed in the lab. Beverages are OK as long as they are in a spill-proof container.
- Before starting the lab, ensure all equipment is in working order. If unsure, do not allow students to use the equipment and notify the supervisor as soon as possible.
- At the beginning of every lab, do a roll call.
- Check the first aid kit.
- Before you exit the lab:
 - If equipment breaks down during your session, leave a note for the next TA and notify the supervisor.
 - Ensure that both doors to the lab are locked, unless the next TA is already present.
